

HAMILTON INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT CRANE OPERATION APPROVAL PROCEDURES

All crane activity in the vicinity of John C. Munro Hamilton International Airport on lands located within the obstacle limitation surfaces as outlined in the John C. Munro Hamilton International Airport Zoning regulations, is subject to review and approval prior to erection.

For reference purposes, an illustration map of the zoned area is attached.

Notification must be submitted, and approvals obtained from the following bodies:

- **NAV Canada**
 - Land Use Submission Form
 - Available for download at www.navcanada.ca (see land use program)
- **Hamilton (YHM) International Airport**
 - Facilities Department (905) 667 8764 or
 - Duty Manager (905) 667 8781

Land use form should be submitted to NAV Canada at least 30 days prior to the start of erection.

After approval is obtained from NAV Canada, notification and final approval is required from Hamilton International Airport at least 48 hours prior to erection

INFORMATION REQUIRED FOR EVERY CRANE NOTIFICATION

- Project contact information
- Site address
- Crane location coordinates (longitude & latitude)
- Ground elevation (ASL)
- Crane maximum boom height
- Crane details (painted, fitted with/without obstruction light)
- Duration of operation
 - Start/end dates
 - Hours of operation
- Scope of work

Crane use without the above approvals in place will be ordered to immediately cease operation and may be subject to disciplinary action from Transport Canada.
